The Main Airlines that travel to Guyana are Delta, Caribbean Airline, Suriname Airline, EZJet, Air Canada and LIAT.

Students booking their flight should look for a flight from one of these airlines or a flight connecting with one of these airlines.

Route to Guyana

New York, Miami, Toronto, London, Caracas, Boa vista, Port-of Spain.



Health Related Information:

- Non Guyanese Residents have access to both Public Health and Private Health Facilities in Guyana
- Medical Supplies are relatively available at pharmacies and other distributors across Guyana.
- A pharmacy is within walking distance from AISM.
- Basic over the counter drugs are readily available at the Admin office.
- When visiting Guyana you are required to have Yellow Fever Vaccine.

Weather

Guyana is a tropical country with 2 seasons, rainy and sunny; average low temperature 24 °C (75.2 °F) and average high temperature of 32 °C. (89.6°F).

Dress Code

Students are required to dress causal for classes. For clinical sessions scrubs and student doctor coat are required. When students are obligated to make presentations and official visits they are required to dress professionally.

Banking and Finance

Students can open Bank Accounts at the local Banks. There are also facilities to use Credit Cards and Debit Cards. Western Union and Money Gram are the two main money transfer companies in Guyana.
